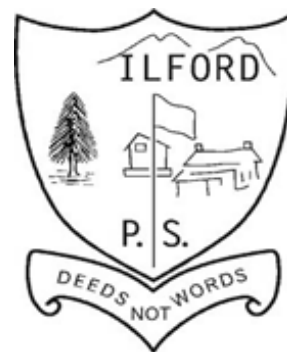

End of the Week

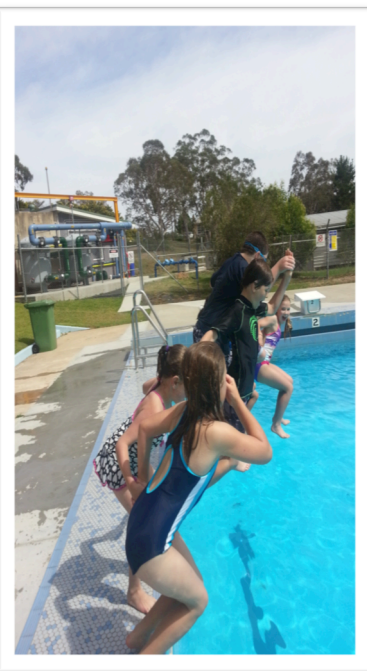
