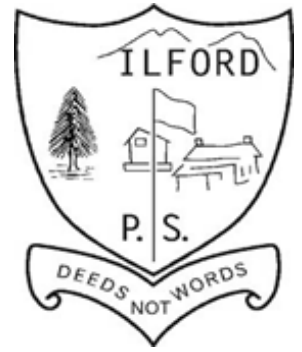

**Small Schools Eisteddfod**

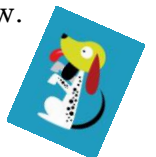
