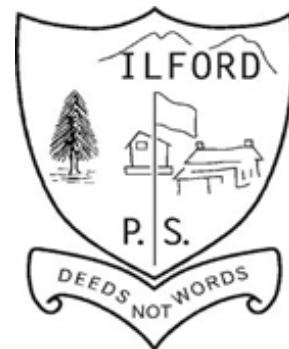

Canteen

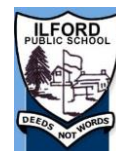

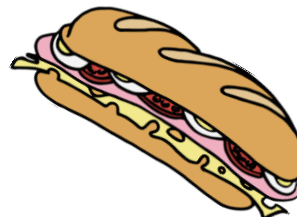
