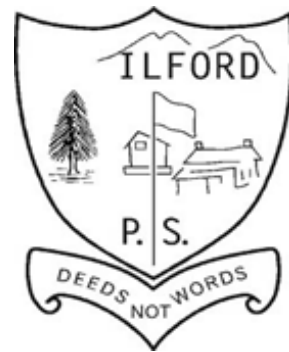

### Banking

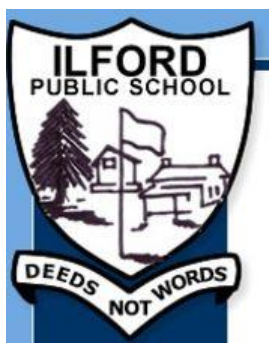
Banking is on Wednesday, so remember to put banking books in the cream box in the residence.
