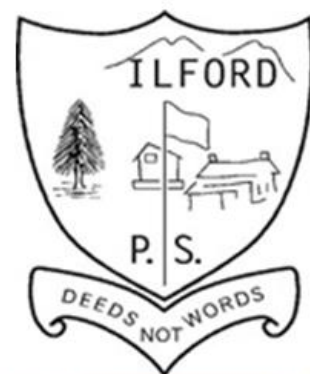

Family Games Night

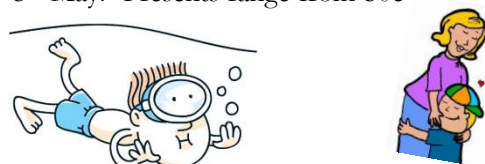
